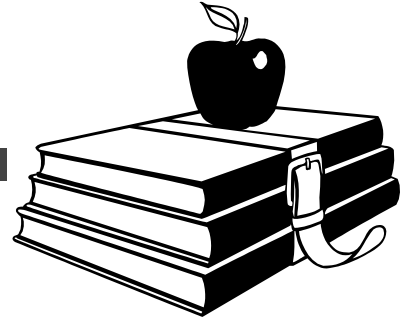

Dr. Scott Steckler was the guest speaker on Tuesday, February 11, 2003 at a Teach for America event, which was co-sponsored by the Clark Honors College (CHC) and Teach for America to inform and develop interest among CHC students about Teach for America.

Dr. Steckler has a PhD in Education Administration from the George Peabody College and has over 30 years of teaching and administrative experience. He spoke to CHC students on the topic "Equal Educational Opportunity – True or False?" an examination of high-stakes testing, the merits of affirmative action, and equality in public education.

Following Dr. Steckler's lecture, Monica Price, a representative from Teach for America (and CHC Alumna) presented the CNN documentary that followed four individuals as first year teachers in the program and their struggles as first year teachers.
