## The CHC wants YOU for a Leadership Opportunity!

We're looking for 15 diverse HC students interested in building CHC community by becoming group leaders in the Clark Honors Introductory Program (CHIP). CHIP is an introduction program for incoming HC freshman that will be implemented beginning next fall.

Each CHIP leader will mentor a group of approximately 10-15 freshmen by providing interest-based social and academic support, and by introducing new students to the CHC, the University, and Eugene in the form of bi-weekly seminars.

The CHIP groups will be divided according to interest: Science, Pre-Med, Pre-Law, Business, Journalism, Architecture, Music, Humanities, Social Science, International Studies, Languages, Sports, Outdoor Pursuits, Community Service, and the Arts. We need CHIP leaders with knowledge in all of these areas.

Being a CHIP leader is a 20-25 hour commitment for Fall term, and in compensation for their service, CHIP leaders will receive a \$75 stipend, available class credit (your choice), as well as free food at the meetings where food is provided, a free HC t-shirt, and a free or very reduced price field trip to a location of interest to your CHIP group (for example, OMSI, a production at the Hult Center, or an Outdoor Program excursion).

CHIP leaders will begin by attending a mandatory training session September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2008, where they will prepare to meet their CHIP groups at New Student Orientation on the 25<sup>th</sup>.

Information sessions will be held on Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, at 3:30pm and 7:00pm in the CHC Library.

Applications are due the following Monday, May 26<sup>th</sup> in the office. Interviews will be held that week, and applicants will be notified of the decisions by June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
